
No. A/1/2016- MOBC (NSP): In pursuance of the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India's mailed letter F. No. 13/2/2016-SS dated 13/12/2016, it is hereby informed to all the concerned Minority students to keep their bank account (which has been given for receiving scholarship through NSP 2.0) **ACTIVE**. There have been instances where the scholarship amount could not be credited through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode in bank accounts of some students due to bank account status showing **Non-active/Non-operational/Dormant/Transaction limit fixed account**, etc. Moreover, it has also been reported that in many cases, bank account validation in PFMS has not been successful as some students are having bank account where Core Banking is not available.

2. It is, therefore, informed that the student has to ensure that
- i) Name on account no. should be the same as per the student name in the scholarship form,
 - ii) IFSC Code and Account Number of the student should be correct,
 - iii) Bank account number should not be stopped/closed before transferring the scholarship amount,
 - iv) Bank account number should be operative,
 - v) Bank account number should not have any fixed credit limit,
 - vi) Bank account number should not be an NRI account/Loan account,
 - vii) Bank account number should not have Minor/Major status issue,
 - viii) In case of Joint Bank Account, student name should be the first in Bank Account.
